

10 Great ways to pass on your values

Three Steps: Identify - Model - Teach Your Values

1. **Story Telling:**
 - a. From books
 - b. Make up your own
 - c. Bible
 - d. Family stories
 - e. Child's story

2. **Game Playing:** use games to teach values and basic character traits (winning/losing)

3. **Create Routines:** this reinforces values and habits (form your habit/they form you)

4. **Affirmation:** affirm every demonstration you see of positive value

5. **Have Assigned Chores/Have Animals to Care for**

6. **Allowance:** use allowance to teach financial and stewardship values

7. **Gold Slips:** child experiences immediate positive & negative consequences when values are enacted (Gold Slips are a reward system with corresponding prizes given when a certain # are reached.)

8. **Movies:**
 - a. Using as a teaching tools
 - b. Go on a values search as you watch a movie with child

9. **Enlist Other Influences:**
 - a. School
 - b. Sunday School
 - c. Teachers
 - d. Coaches
 - e. Relatives
 - f. Friends
 - g. Parents
 - h. Youth Pastor
 - i. Piano Teachers

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10. Experiential Learning:

- a. Provide meaningful experiences which have potential for shaping positive values. (I hear - I forget; I see - I remember; I do - I change)
- b. Cross Cultural Experiences
- c. Mission Events
- d. Community Services

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
